Since the debut in last year's musical 'Beauty and the Beast', LFH students have been expected to deliver another excellent musical to the audience.

As one of the English Enhancement Scheme programmes for JS2 students, musical aims to marry language arts and English learning in order to raise students' interest in the language.

In this year's musical — 'Sound of Music', a total of 120 JS2 students were involved in the front stage performance. All students including teams of backstage, costumes, props and sets, publicity, choir, lighting and sound and so on have gained more than what they could imagine. Appreciations from guests, self-confidence, dignity, courage, growing passion in English, to name a few, are the bountiful fruits that students bear after their hard work.

Teaching in Japan and China

Osaka, Japan

Twenty-one senior level students and four English teachers participated in The Osaka Experience on 1 to 5 February 2008 and had lessons with students at Yuhigaoka High School, Osaka, Japan. The many-fold objectives included the application of the English language, the exploration of Kansai culture, and the understanding of environment issues germane to Osaka. Generic skills like negotiation and map-reading also abounded on the trip. Some students were more interested in promoting friendship with their new friends in Osaka.

Qing Yuen, China

Teaching in China (2008-9) embarks a new chapter for S6 students. Combining leadership training, students were able to experience how to teach and how to be a leader. The 5-day trip began on 25 September. Students were grouped and led by experienced teachers and social workers to serve the junior form students in a poverty-stricken area — Qing Yuen. Through the service, LFH students were able to learn the hardship of the local students and appreciate their own fortune. Leadership training was another highlight of the trip. Different challenges of intelligence and physical strength were arranged, and our students performed incredibly well in every single challenge. In a reflection session, all S6 students expressed that they have grown up a lot, and are confident to take up leadership roles.





English Enhancement Programmes

Form	Programme	Description
JS1	Food Festival	Students read articles regarding meals, food tradition, and cultural dishes in English lessons. Some dishes will be demonstrated in Home Economics classes. English-medium cooking classes are also arranged for students so that they can apply the language through cooking.
JS2	Musical	All students are put on stage to perform a musical. Each student ia assigned a role to play — actors, choir, backstage, costume, and so on. Through a common goal, students are expected to work together to build up their confidence and enhance their English proficiency.
JS3 & S6	History-English Project	JS3 students are grouped and led by S6 students to watch a historically-themed movie every year. Related tasks like discussion, project learning and film appreciation will be conducted to increase students' exposure of English.
S4	SBA Exhibition	Based on SBA books and movies, students in groups design posters, banners, and game stalls for the SBA Exhibition which is very popular among teachers and students.
S4	Generic Skills Training	Students learn self-management, study, problem-solving, communication skills in English classes.
S5 & S7	Oral Practice	S5 & S7 students will meet with students from other schools, monitored by English teachers, to do oral presentation and group discussion.
S6	Teaching English outside Hong Kong	All S6 students go on a trip to teach English in remote areas. They will prepare a curriculum and teach their peers simple English. It is hoped that students can enrich their own language knowledge and experience the hardship through the activity.



Platforms for Students to Shine

SBA Exhibition

In order to enhance the reading skills of all S4 students and get them prepared for the SBA, a book fair is held in January, every year. All S4 students need to set up their booths not only with the synopsis and the main characters of the story, but also one or two related games to make their booths more attractive and fun.

The activity provides hands-on experience for students to create their own storyboards. Students are successfully encouraged to read and share their readings. It is definitely a golden opportunity for students to better themselves on both language and communication skills.

National Geographic Channel Think Again Award

Every year, S6 students will participate in the Think Again Awards Documentary Making Competition. It is a golden chance for students to integrate their English skills with creativity and video-making technique. In the year 2008, our S6 students won the crown award, the THINK AGAIN AWARD, one distinction and

數理活動重嘗試 創意特技冶一爐

科學大匯演透過多元化的活動解釋科學理論,讓學生親身體 驗,親身嘗試各種理論的實驗。活動包括:「看」抽象的聲 波、觸碰乾冰肥皂泡、研究不同密度的氣體如何使物件懸浮 半空、聽不同密度的氣體如何使老師聲帶變調、試驗陀螺的 角動量,最後學生更進入黑漆地庫觀察法證科學常用的好幫 手魯米諾如何發光。是次活動除了提升同學對科學的興趣, 更擴闊了同學的視野,引起了他們的科學探究精神。

數理週首先透過深入淺出的介紹,讓同學認識科學界舉足輕 重的人物,例如數學家祖沖之、生物學家金納、物理學家牛 頓、化學家法拉第。另外,利用不同的攤位遊戲,如飛機升 會生活與數理科息息相關。





校外比賽啟潛能 樂於服務重環保

榮獲港燈清新能源基金資助

本校於本年度榮獲香港電燈有限公司清新能源基金資助港幣九萬九千圓,發展「負碳排放維生水利系統」。我們將於天台環保園建造以可再生能源推動的池塘維生及灌溉系統。有關系統分為兩部份,第一部份為「可再生能源系統」,以太陽能光伏板加風力渦輪混合發電,為天台提供能源。第二部份為推動「維生水利系統」,以電水泵輸送雨水、過濾池水、以廢水灌溉耕種及為天台地面灑水降溫。

由於本設計以12伏特操作,格外安全,而且整個項目融合教學示範、天台綠化研究、節能減排,在提供電力之餘,亦能兼顧安全問題。故此,我校能從眾多參加者中脱穎而出。本校製作專案報告後,將向社會各界推廣本校經驗及環保教育訊息。

此外,本校奪得「綠色學校獎優異獎」,多名學生亦獲頒發「學界環保大使優異獎」及「海洋公園攜手保育生態獎勵計劃」金章。7S班李恩琳同學更榮獲保育大自然義賣活動之「最優秀義工獎」。

本校積極推行各類型的社會服務及社區活動,使學生更清楚認識自己、社區及外地文化,培養他們對不同階層人士的同感心、關注和尊重。社會服務組於本學年參與了多項社區服務,包括探訪混合幼兒中心、幼稚園和居長者等:更鼓勵全校參與公益金便服日、飢饉午餐、賣旗、捐血日、舊書買賣等活動。此外,本校四十二二義工同學更獲得「社會福利署義工運動」義工服務嘉許金銀銅狀,而6S陳泳昌同學亦獲得同濟會積極參與社會服務義工大獎,足以肯定本校同學在服務人群方面的主動性、積極性和貢獻。於母親節前夕,本校更舉行康乃馨及曲奇義賣,為向晴軒籌款,善款數目再刷新紀錄。


