A survey report on students' attitude towards the musical shows

#### Introduction


Thanks for your letter. I'm sorry to hear about your problems. I hope I can give you some advice that will help you.

Good morning, Principal, teachers and students. I am John Lee from Class 5C. Today I would like to talk about an annual charity walkathon event. I would like to share my experience here.




Mysterious Disappearance of English Teacher: Student Suspected



## Re: Complaint about Kingdom Education tutorial centre in Chai Wan

I am Chris Wong, one of the students of Tony Chan who is an English tutor in Kingdom Education tutor in Kingdom Education tutorial centre in Chai Wan. 


